Online Registration

NEW STUDENTS

Please make sure you send in a copy of your birth certificate and proof of residency (electric bill, water bill, etc.) Both documents can also be uploaded into harmony.

If you have any custody paperwork, please send a copy to the office.

Student Drop off & Pick up

For the safety of students and staff we have set drop off and pick up procedures.

AM Drop off – Between the times of 7:30 and 7:50, Jr/Sr High Students will need to be dropped off in parking lot, away from car rider line, and walk across the lot. No students are to be dropped off at the entrances of the school during this time due to the elementary car rider line.

If students arrive at school after 7:55 a.m.,

they are considered tardy and must sign in at the office. PM Pick up – No students should be picked up at the front of the building during dismissal until the elementary car rider line has ended.

After buses/car rider line drivers have left, students may be picked up at the school entrance. **Do not pick up or drop off your child at the curb near the main entrances when any buses are present before or after school.**

Lunches and Visitors to the building

Due to the large number of students in our lunches we do not allow parents/friends, etc to visit during lunch for grades 7-12. If you visit the building and are going past the front door for **ANY REASON, then YOU MUST sign in at the office.**

You will be asked to provide the office with a state issued ID to be scanned and a visitor sticker printed. This sticker should be worn at all times while in the building.

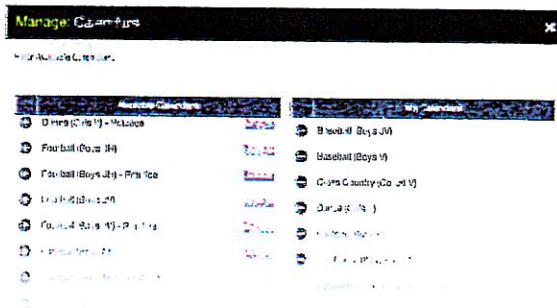
